This \$1000 scholarship recognizes a student who is either from or studying in Newfoundland and Labrador whose interests, activities and post-secondary goals are focused on the conservation of habitat in Newfoundland and Labrador.

To be eligible, students must be:

- (1) Resident of or studying in the province of Newfoundland and Labrador;
- (2) Enrolled (or entering) in a post-secondary program; and
- (3) Have demonstrated an active commitment to conservation in Newfoundland and Labrador.

SAM reserves the right to not grant any funds should no qualified applicants come forward. Complete application packages must include the filled in application form (attached), a copy of your resume/ C.V., AND a transcript (unofficial or official).
